

# INFORMATION PUBLICATION SCHEME

## About the scheme

Under the *Freedom of Information Amendment (Reform) Act 2010*, all Commonwealth agencies subject to the *Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act)*, including the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC), are required to have an Information Publication Scheme (IPS).

The scheme commenced on 1 May 2011 and requires the ACNC to publish a broad range of information and make it available for downloading where possible.
