

Australia's Aged Care Charities in 2015

This report profiles the 1,465 charities registered with the Australian Charities and Not-for-profits Commission (ACNC) which listed their main activity as aged care.

Produced by the Centre for Social Impact in partnership with the Social Policy Research Centre at the University of New South Wales, this specialised report analyses data specific to aged care charities, submitted through the 2015 Annual Information Statement.

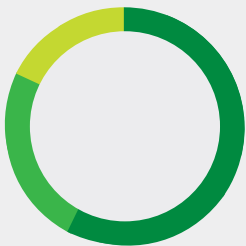

Employment in aged care charities

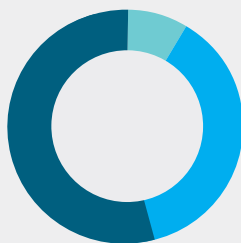
Aged care charities employ over **171,000** paid staff, which accounts for 14% of all charity employees



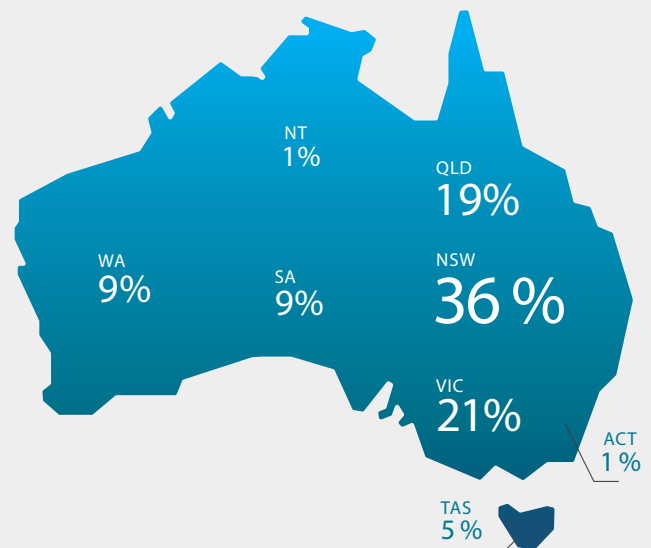
- 61% of staff are employed part time
- 23% of staff are employed casually
- 16% of staff are employed full time

Aged care charities had combined total income over

\$12.5 billion



- 51% from other income and revenue, including sales, member fees and user pays
- 48% from government grants
- 1% from donations and bequests



93% operate in one state or territory

54% are based in major cities

6% operate in several states/territories

27% are based in inner regional areas

1% operate in every state and territory

19% are based in outer regional, remote or rural areas
